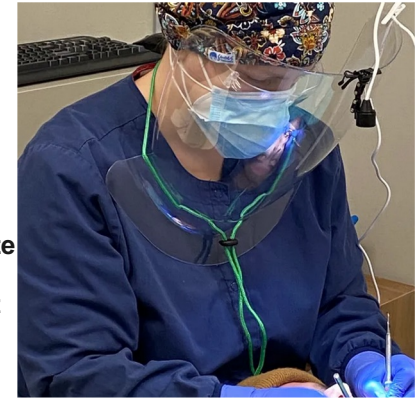
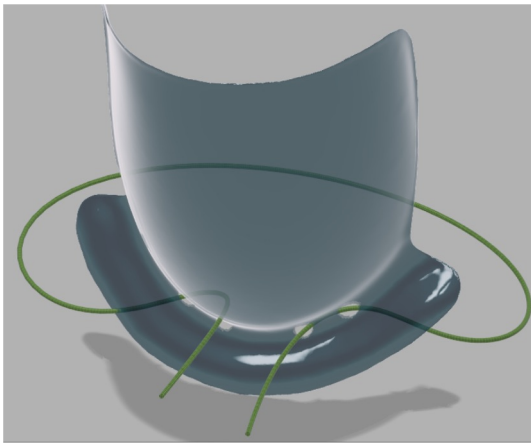


CC Shield

Summary



The CC Shield was invented by Shawn Thompson.

The CC Shield was designed as a reusable, face shield offering complete coverage of the face and neck. The present invention finds use in the dental and healthcare industry. It also has proven effective and efficient for use by nail technicians, in sanding and wood-working applications and others.

The device has a formed clear shield and a drawstring assembly that is useful to comfortably and adjustably attach the CC Shield adjacent the face of a user-wearer. The shield has a chest-engaging portion to stabilize it for use offset to the face of the wearer. When the shield invention is used (worn) it prevents debris, dust and the like from coming into contact with the face, neck and lungs of the host-user, yet allows sufficient space for breathing. The novel shield is not head-mounted, rather it is neck-mounted to allow for greater control in use.

As designed, the present invention provides an efficient and effective means to cover the face, allowing clear viewing and can be worn comfortably.
