SUMMARY

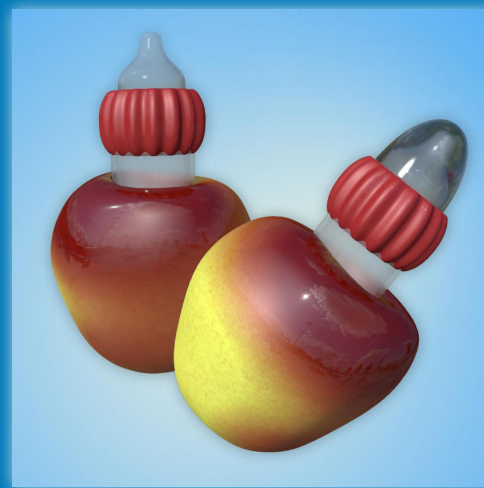
Children are notorious for not wanting to eat their vegetables. But what if they had a positive reinforcement of vegetables from the start?

The NutriCups™ are BPA-free plastic bottles and containers.

The nipples can be replaced with many different styles as the child grows changing them from baby bottles to sippy cups making them more economical as well for the cost-conscious parent, and those with limited storage space.

It could be used in any of the phases of childhood as long as it was needed, depending on the child’s ability and desire to drink from the different tops.
